### Every Woman on Earth

Getting married, every woman hopes that her marriage will be the strongest; that her spouse will be the most faithful and reliable; and their children will be the most obedient, meeting expectations of their parents. This is the way it happened in my life.

I met my future husband, Igor, for whom a family and children was the first priority in life, and we got married. We buried our first child and took it as a will of God. In 3 years our daughter Anya was born. Time flew. My husband wanted a son and a brother for Anya. We made a decision, and I got pregnant again. Igor was overjoyed. Everything seemed to be going so well, but unexpectedly my husband died in a car accident. I was four months pregnant. In a short time I lost another beloved person. I didn't want to live...

On the day of the funeral one of my friends said: "Olya! Don't worry! Good people will help you". I couldn't even imagine who would help me and how. The next Monday she took me to some place. It turned out to be Mission to Ukraine (MTU). We received a warm welcome from a counselor. She listened to my problem and shared about help available. Soon our wonderful baby boy was born.

In difficult times of my life at MTU they would always listen to me and give advice. When I needed material assistance, they helped me with food and formula. And most importantly, they gave me assurance in tomorrow.
