At present the Lord allows MTU physical therapists to treat at least 15 children with different disabilities at the MTU clinic daily. He provides a ride to those of them who are in wheel chairs and gives a special blessing to families from villages to stay in a cottage on the MTU grounds.

Unbelievable Help Available For Free

Little Vadim, a 5 year old boy with cerebral palsy, lives in a small village in the Zhitomir region. Last year his parents borrowed a large sum of money from a bank in order to treat his disability at a well-known rehabilitation center in another part of Ukraine. This money was needed for early therapy intervention. They paid for the treatment as well as lodgings and medications. It left them impoverished even more, but also sad as they didn't see a desirable progress in their child's development.

On their return a local hospital doctor mentioned Mission to Ukraine's clinic to them. Tears

filled the mother's eyes when she came to MTU and learned that similar help was available for free. We pointed her to Jesus, in whose name free therapy, free lodging, and free medication is given.

Her excitement multiplied when she saw much improvement in Vadim's condition and learned how to help him exercise on his own.

We praise the Lord for the opportunity to minister to Vadim's family and invite you to pray for them to see Christ behind this help and accept Him into their hearts.
