LifeSavers is Mission to Ukraine's benevolence program that extends the love of Christ in tangible ways. It is a special way of saying "God loves you" and to show it with deeds. Through the provision of food,

clothing, medical and dental care, medicines, counseling, and items as needed that we are able to provide, women and children, our primary aid recipients, see the care of those who follow Christ.

1. Pray for the Lord to guide more women with crisis pregnancies to Mission to Ukraine.

2. Pray for the women in the LifeSavers program to open their hearts to Jesus.

3. Pray for the women who have graduated from the LifeSavers program to seek God and join churches.

4. Alyona Kasyanchuk, MTU crisis pregnancy counselor, celebrates her birthday today. Pray for Alyona to grow in wisdom and patience, for her young

daughter, Anastasia, to mature into a Godly woman, and for her family members to accept Christ into their hearts.

5. Pray for the men of our LifeSavers women to take responsibility for their families and become supportive of their wives and girlfriends. Pray for their release from drugs and alcohol abuse and for them to find gainful employment.

6. Pastor Peter Levchenko, a long-time friend of the MTU's ministry, celebrates his birthday today. Pray for God's provision for his family, for his continued good health, for the

pastors he leads, and for the expansion and protection of his ministry.

7. Please pray for LifeSavers' child, David Lefterov. In his five month of life, he has endured two bouts of pneumonia and the chicken pox which have left him with serious ongoing medical issues. Pray for his mother to receive strength from God and continue seeking Him.

8. Pray for the Lord to turn the hearts of Ukrainian OB/GYNs towards life. Pray that the government would promote pro-life policies.

9. Pray for the LifeSavers mothers to bring their children to Sunday school classes.

10. Pray for the mothers who will participate in our summer day camp 2010 to accept God into their hearts. Pray that they will see God as their loving and faithful father and the healer of broken hearts.

11. Pray for the Lord to reveal Himself during the youth day camp to our LifeSavers' children and their siblings. Help the leaders to plan activities that clearly illustrate to the children the love of Christ.

12. Pray for unity and love of the US and Ukrainian camp teams. Thank God for every person who will be serving Him during the camps.

13. Pray for the successful completion of the playground at MTU, so that we could use it for our day camps.

14. Pray for volunteers, Rosa and Olya, who lead Bible studies for the Lifesavers women. Pray for the Lord to use them powerfully in transforming women's lives.

15. Pray for the Lord's continued financial provision for the LifeSavers program. Ask that He would move in people's hearts to sponsor a LifeSavers family with a monthly gift.

16. The LifeSavers program in Berdichev, a small town about an hour west of Zhitomir, is possible thanks to our faithful

volunteer, Inna Klimova, working in the local hospital. Pray for the doors of the hospital to remain open to the crisis pregnancy ministry.

17. Pray for continued support our ministry with prenatal vitamins, diapers, and medicines. Thank him for the countless ways in which he provides for MTU's ministry.

18. Ira Venglovskaya, MTU manager, has her birthday today. Pray for our God to bless Ira with strength and wisdom in fulfilling her ministry. Ask that God would draw her family to Him.

19. Praise God for the containers loaded with clothing and baby furnishings. Thank God for every person involved in donating, packing, and delivering those goods to the neediest Ukrainian women and children.

20. Praise God for MTU's advertising campaign that, with the use of billboards, posters, and public transportation advertisements, brings women to MTU.

21. Praise to God for the high quality humanitarian food for the LifeSavers children provided through the local Messianic Jews Congregation. Pray for Pastor Arkadiy and Natasha Krasovskaya's ministry to reach many Jews for Jesus.

22. Pray that the Lord would use our monthly LifeSavers celebration meetings to draw these women closer to Him and to change their lives.

23. Pray for the MTU crisis pregnancy counselors and volunteers to have wisdom and strength in doing God's work. Ask that He would refresh them daily.

24. Most of the LifeSavers families live in extreme poverty. Please, pray for their living circumstances to improve.

25. The number of cases of birth traumas in Ukraine remains high. Please, pray for God's protection of the LifeSavers babies.

26. Please pray for MTU's gynecologist, Ema Snidevich, to remain open to God's work through her and to commit her life to Jesus.

27. We are grateful to God for the local pastors cooperating with us and shepherding LifeSavers women in their area churches. Pray for God's strength, wisdom, and provision for them.

28. Pray for Berdichev volunteers to keep the fire burning and reach out to more women with crisis pregnancies.

29. Pray for the Lord to continue blessing Natalia Krasovskaya, head of the crisis pregnancy ministry, with guidance, vision and wisdom to fulfill His will.

30. Pray for the LifeSavers women to see God behind every good gift they receive through Mission to Ukraine's services.

31. Pray for the local churches to grow in reaching out to the LifeSavers women.
