'Unwanted pregnancy? We can help you!' she read on a billboard near her university. Now that the changes in her body signaled the possible pregnancy, she really needed to use their service. Alyona and her friend, Ivan, came to MTU for a pregnancy test. On the pre-interview questionnaire they circled the abortion option if the test turned out to be positive. They made up their minds, and so the counselor asked one of the co-workers to pray for the work of the Holy Spirit at the session...

Alyona was 18. She was just a freshman at the University. She had only begun her real life. Ivan was 22. He had a job. He was acquiring real life experience. They just lived together for now without any promises or plans. They wanted an abortion.

When the counselor explained the procedure of abortion and the possible consequences, they had no words to say. After a minute of the abortion video, they asked to stop the VCR. 'So what do you think?' followed the counselor's question ... After a pause, the young man stated 'We will have a wedding!' Alyona burst into tears. Happy, they left the counseling room.
