### *Parents of Children with Disabilities*

The impact these camps make in the lives of these destitute, isolated, broken-hearted families, most of whom live below the poverty line, goes beyond words. For eight days the families eat wholesome food and eat enough. They live without

Pray with us that the seeds of truth planted grow in their hearts. Pray that God's Word continues to transform their lives. To open more of God's work into their lives this year, we gave parents the opportunity to share their prayer requests with us. We hope you join us in these prayers.
